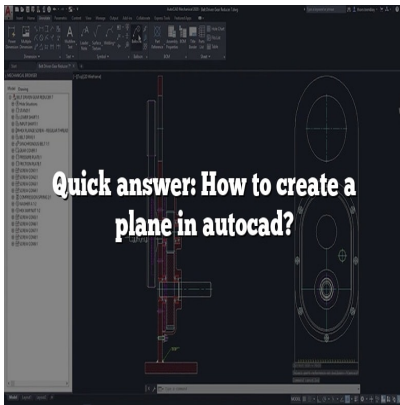

It is an infinite construction plane that can be placed at any orientation in space. It can be offset from an existing work plane, or it can reference 3D geometry.

As the name implies, a planar surface is simply a surface that is a **plane**, where a **plane** is a flat 2-dimensional surface that is straight in two directions. In other words, a plane (and planar surface) is a flat 2-dimensional surface with a length and a width, but

no height.

How do you create a work plane in Autodesk Inventor?

1. On the ribbon, click 3D Model tab Work Features panel . Then, choose the type of plane you want to create and select the appropriate geometry: Plane. Creates a construction plane through selected objects.
2. If applicable, click the check mark in the edit box to accept the preview and create the plane.

How do I create a work plane in Revit?

1. On the Architecture tab, Work Plane group, click Show to show your current work plane.
2. Click Set to open the Set Work Plane window.
3. Choose Pick a Plane.
4. Click on an elements face to set it as the new Work Plane.

How do you create an XY plane in AutoCAD?

1. Click View menu 3D Views Plan View.
2. Select one of the following options: Current (for the current UCS) World (for the WCS) Named (for a saved UCS) Note: PLAN changes the viewing direction; it does not change the current UCS.

What is a drawing plane?

A projection plane, or plane of projection, is a type of view in which graphical projections form an object intersect. Projection planes are used often in descriptive geometry and graphical representation. A picture plane in perspective drawing is a type of projection plane.

How many planes are in AutoCAD?

The three axes of a workspace listed below define three planes. These are known as the principal planes: the XY plane lies through the X and Y axes. the ZX plane lies through the X and Z axes.

How do you make a line coplanar in AutoCAD?

1. Select all of the lines to be modified.
2. Right-click and select Properties.
3. Set Start Z and End Z to 0 (zero) or another consistent value. The default may show "Varies".

How do I set Z 0 in AutoCAD?

1. Type in the CHANGE command.
2. Type ALL to select all objects and then Enter.
3. Type P for Properties.
4. Type E for Elevation.
5. Type 0 and then a final Enter to end the command.

Which plane is used to draw all objects in AutoCAD?

Generally in AutoCAD, all objects are drawn on the XY plane.

What is planar shape?

The central and surrounding atoms in a trigonal planar molecule lie on one plane (hence the term planar). This gives it more of a two-dimensional shape than three-dimensional. The bonds are spread equally around the plane, forming 120 degree bond angles.

What is a planar structure?

Planar: Said of a molecule when all of its atoms lie in the same plane. Can also be said for a portion of a molecule, such as a ring. Atoms, groups, bonds, or other objects lying within the same plane are periplanar or coplanar. Lewis structure.

What is a planar form?

Planar forms are composed of long and thin wide shapes that articulate the space. Though mathematically, a plane is a flat surface having two exaggerated dimensions, it may be classified as a planar form.

How do I convert 3D to 2D in AutoCAD?

If you are using AutoCAD 2007 and higher, the FLATSHOT command is available to convert 3D solids to flattened 2D views. (Note this command is not available in AutoCAD LT, so use the alternate method described.) Click Application menu > Print > Manage Plotters. Double-click the Add-a-Plotter Wizard shortcut icon.

How do I draw a 3D model in AutoCAD?

1. Click Drawing View Creation tab Select panel Model Space Selection. Find.
2. SHIFT-click the objects you don't want to include in the base view. Tip: If you accidentally removed an object that you didn't intend to, click the object.

3. Press ENTER to return to the layout.

How do you make a 2D model from 3D in AutoCAD?

Change your view to Front from View cube or View drop down menu and again select FLATSHOT command. Select all the options from Flatshot dialogue box as you have selected in the previous condition of the Top view and click on Create. In this case, also the 2D drawing of Front view will follow the cursor.
