1. Click Output tab Plot panel Plot. Find.
2. Select a plotter.
3. Select paper size, plot area, plot scale, orientation and other options.
4. For additional options, click the More Options button.

How do you plot a lot with coordinates?

STEP 1 – Draw and label the x and y axis. STEP 2 – Plot the coordinates (2,3). Remember the x (horizontal) is the first number in the brackets and the y (vertical) is the second number. Now plot the rest of the coordinates.

How do I draw a line distance in AutoCAD?

1. Click Drafting tab > Draw panel > Line.
2. Specify the first point and then, move the cursor the same angle as the line that you want to create.
3. Enter a distance at the prompt.

How do you draw surveyor units in AutoCAD?

1. Begin a new drawing, then turn on Dynamic Input (DYN button) on the Status bar.
2. Launch the Line command, then specify the first point.
3. For the next point, enter the following value: @50.71

How do I plot latitude and longitude in AutoCAD?

1. Click Geolocation tab > Tools panel > Mark Position drop-down > Lat-Long.
2. Specify the latitude of the location and press ENTER.
3. Specify the longitude of the location and press ENTER.

How do you plot layout?

1. Right-click on Model or Layout tab / choose Page Setup Manager from the shortcut menu.
2. Page Setup Manager dialog box / Click New button.
3. Type new page setup name.
4. Page Setup dialog box / Choose your plotting settings / Ok.

How do I draw multiple lines in AutoCAD?

1. At the command prompt, enter MLINE.
2. At the Command prompt, enter st to select a style.
3. To list available styles, enter the style name or enter ?.
4. To justify the multiline, enter j and select top, zero, or bottom justification.
5. To change the scale of the multiline, enter s and enter a new scale.

How do I use the line command in AutoCAD?

1. Open the AutoCAD software.
2. Select the Line icon from the ribbon panel or type L or Line and press Enter on the command line.
3. Specify the starting point and endpoint using the cursor on the workspace or drawing area, as shown in the below image:
4. Press Enter or Esc to exit.
