You asked, how do you move objects freely in SketchUp?

1. With the Select () tool or the Lasso () tool, select the item (or items) you want to move.
2. Select the Move tool () or press the M key.
3. Select the item you want to move and your move point.
4. Move your mouse to move your selection.
5. Click the destination point to finish the move.

Moreover, how do you align objects in **SketchUp**? To align two or more selected elements vertically or horizontally, select Arrange > Align and then select Vertically or Horizontally from the submenu that appears. To center two or more selected elements, select Arrange > Center and then choose Vertically on Page or Horizontally on Page from the submenu.

As many you asked, how do I align **objects** to Axis in **SketchUp**?

1. Open SketchUp.
2. Create an entity.
3. Press spacebar to choose the Select tool.
4. Triple click on the entity.
5. CTRL+ click and select Make Group.
6. Select the Move tool (M) and click on a point, then press an arrow key to lock the axis of motion.
Left arrow = green axis, up = blue and right = red:

Similarly, how do you align furniture in SketchUp? What does Coplanar mean? On the same plane or surface. Two parts of a model that are joined together. The ability for SketchUp to line up two edges.

1. With the Select tool (), select the geometry you want to scale.
2. Select the Scale tool () or press the S key.
3. Click an edge or face grip (not a corner grip).
4. Move the cursor to scale the entity.
5. Click to set your selection's new scale.

How do you align views in SketchUp?

Tip: To quickly align SketchUp's point of view to be top-down with axis centered, context-click a drawing axis and select Align View from the menu that appears.

There are a couple of "flatten" plugins but no native command to "flatten" your model. SketchUp Pro users can export a 2D plan view to DWG or DXF format and re-import that into SketchUp.

How do you flatten topography in Sketchup?

How do you make an exact dimension in SketchUp?

Type a length value, a comma, a width value, and then press Enter. For example, type 8",20" and press Enter. If you type only a number or numbers, SketchUp uses the current document units setting.

You can also override the document units setting by specifying imperial (such as 1'6") or metric (such as 3.652m) units.

1. Set up the view of the 3D model.
2. Click Home tab Section panel Flatshot.
3. In the Flatshot dialog box, under Destination, click one of the options.
4. Change the color and linetype settings for Foreground and Obscured lines.
5. Click Create.

1. If you have a cad file with the topo lines at the right height each, simply import it to SketchUp (File → Import → Select DWG as the file format)
2. Then select the topo lines in SketchUp and click on the "from Contours" button in the Sandbox Tool Bar.

SketchUp is 100% precise. When you type in a dimension into the VCB, SketchUp will draw or move the entity to that exact location.
