

# Quick answer: How to put sky in vray sketchup?

## Introduction

To add the Sky texture as an Environment one, go to Textures and select the auto-generated Environment Texture. Press the Replace With New Texture button and select the **Sky** texture instead.

Similarly, how do I add **Sky** to **SketchUp**? Select the Edit tab. Select the Background Settings icon ( ) just below the tab name. Choose your desired background, sky, and ground options.

You asked, how do I get **VRAY** on Sky?

As many you asked, how do I add Hdri to SketchUp? To load the HDRI, all you need to do is click the small **☰** highlighted at (1) and then click type **Bitmap**, then on the Bitmap File highlighted at (2). Next browse the location of the HDRI file in your computer (3).

Amazingly, how do you turn on the sunlight in VRAY? Select **TexSky** from dropdown menu which is basically a skylight system that's enabled in V-Ray. Then it will give you the options for a sun. In the Default Sky Options at the top, select **Sun 1** from the dropdown "this is the SketchUp sun.

## How do you put dome lights on VRAY?

1. Choose Dome Light from the V-ray Toolbar.
2. Switch off the Environment Light from the V-ray Asset Editor Settings.
3. Once you've added the Dome Light, it shows up in the Lights Section of the Vray Asset Editor.
4. I've changed it to a Vatican Road HDRI.

## How do I make a background transparent in SketchUp?

Do this by navigating to File > Export > 2D graphic. Click on the "options" button in the lower right corner next to "export." The "extended export image options" window will appear. Under the rendering options, make sure you have "transparent background" and "anti-alias" selected. Close the window.

## How do I change the color of my sky on VRAY?

Within the V-Ray option editor, go to the "Environment" tab, set the GI (Skylight) color to yellow, change the intensity to 4.0 and switch of the check-box for the Preetham et. al. simulation on the right.

## How do I turn off VRAY on sky?

simple solution go to render options > Indirect Lighting > Create sun and sky, click this then in the attributes panel (the panel on the right with all the options) you can click it on or off.

## How do I reduce sun light in VRAY?

You can also specify the VRaySun as the sun type inside a 3ds Max Daylight system. Enabled "Turns on and off the sun light. Intensity multiplier1" An intensity multiplier for the VRaySun. Since the sun is very bright by default, you can use this parameter to reduce its effect.

## What is VRAY dome light?

A Dome light is a type of VRayLight that shines inward at the scene as if from a spherical or hemispherical light source outside the scene extents. This light is frequently used for Image-Based lighting using panoramic HDR images used as environments.

How do I get rid of the grey background in layout? If you mean the model background colour, you can turn it on and off. Under the SketchUp model tab, goto styles and you will see a check box for background. Ok great thanks.

## Is V-Ray easy to learn?
