Also, how do you fix **crop view** in Revit?

- 1. In a plan, elevation, or section view, select a crop region and click Edit Modify | view type> tab Mode panel Edit Crop.
- 2. Use the tools on the Modify and Draw panels to edit the **crop** region as needed.
- 3. When you are finished, click Finish Edit Mode.

You asked, how do you crop detail view in **Revit**?

- 1. Go to View Ribbon tab -> Windows Ribbon Panel -> User Interface drop down -> Keyboard Shortcuts (or use the Keyboard Shortcut KS to access this command).
- 2. In the search box type in Crop.
- 3. Find the command **Crop** (Uncrop) View and note the keyboard shortcut.

Correspondingly, can you **crop** a 3D view in Revit? In **Revit**®, the †Section Box†command is used to clip the viewable portion of a 3D view. You can activate it simply by checking the Section Box entry in Properties †Extents. After enabling the section box, you can modify its extents using †drag†controls in the 3D view.

Subsequently, why is crop view greyed out? The †Reset Crop' icon will now be greyed out †indicating the crop is no longer edited.

How do I crop a view?

- 1. In a drawing view, sketch a closed profile such as a circle.
- 2. Click Crop View. (Drawing toolbar), or click Insert > Drawing View > Crop. The view outside the profile disappears. A circle is drawn on this Section View. After cropping, only the view inside the circle is displayed.

How do I crop a viewport in sheet?

- 1. Select the viewport.
- 2. Select the command.
- 3. Click Crop to enter Edit Crop mode.
- 4. Create a 2D object such as a rectangle, circle, or polyline.
- 5. Click Exit Viewport Crop to return to the sheet layer or design layer.
- 6. The cropped viewport displays; in the Object Info palette, the Crop status changes to Yes.

How do I edit crop view?

- 1. Right-click the drawing view in the graphics area or in the FeatureManager design tree and select Crop View > Edit Crop.
- 2. Edit the profile.
- 3. Click Rebuild. to update the view.

How do I resize a viewport in Revit?

Right-click the activated view, and click Pan Active View. Drag the cursor to pan the view. Change the scale of the view. On the View Control Bar, for Scale, select the desired scale.

How do you crop a render in Revit?

Crop region: Open the 3D view, and apply a crop region to define the area to render. To check or change the size of the cropped view, select the crop region, and click Modify | Cameras tab Crop panel (Size Crop).

What is a crop region Revit?

The crop region defines the boundaries for a project view. You can display a model crop region and an annotation crop region in all graphical project views.

How do I resize a 3d view in Revit?

How do you scale a view on a sheet in Revit?

Right-click the activated view, and click Pan Active View. Drag the cursor to pan the view. Change the scale of the view. On the View Control Bar, for Scale, select the desired scale.

How do I enable section box?

To display the section box, in the Properties palette for a 3D view, select Section Box. When a section box is first displayed, the extents of the visible geometry are used to define the extents of the section box. Select the section box and use the grip controls to resize the extents.

Why is scope box greyed out Revit?

There are some situations where the Scope Box property of a view is greyed out – so you cannot assign a Scope Box to the view. The answer may be to do with the Crop Boundary – and it may not be obvious, especially if the crop boundary is hidden.

How do you extend a crop region in Revit?

- 1. In the drawing area, select the crop region.
- 2. Click Modify tab Crop panel (Size Crop).
- 3. If you are modifying a crop region in a perspective 3D view, select either Field of view or Scale (locked proportions).
- 4. Modify the values for width and height.

How do you turn off crop region in Revit?

- 1. On the View Control Bar, click (Show Crop Region or Hide Crop Region).
- 2. In the Properties palette for the view, select or clear the Crop Region Visible setting.

How do you edit annotation crops in Revit?

- 1. Within the Properties palette, check the Crop View, Crop Region Visible, and Annotation Crop checkboxes.
- 2. Within the view, select the Crop Region.
- 3. Use the grip edits to stretch the Annotation boundary as needed.

How do I crop a view in Revit 2018?

Where is the crop region in Revit?

- 1. On the View Control Bar, click (Show Crop Region or Hide Crop Region).
- 2. In the Properties palette for the view, select or clear the Crop Region Visible setting.

How do I turn off annotation cropping in Revit?

After you show crop regions, if the annotation crop region is hidden, right-click in the drawing area, and click View Properties. On the Properties palette, select (or clear) the check box for Annotation Crop.

Can you crop a raster image in Revit?

You can use any shape for the crop border, not just rectangular trimming (see the Edit Profile context ribbon). Then use the cropped raster image (view) on your drawing sheet.

How do you scale a 3D view?

As long as it is a camera view, select the view on the sheet, and in the modify tab, select "Size crop,†check the radio button "Scale†then change the width or height to suit.
