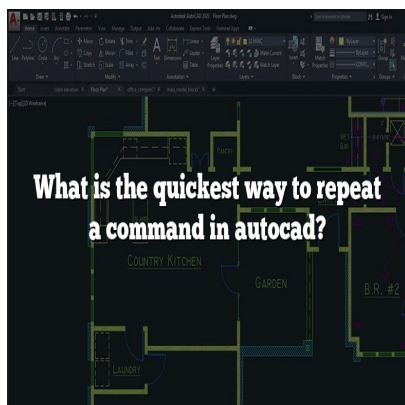




# What is the quickest way to repeat a command in autocad?

Correspondingly, how do you repeat something in AutoCAD? or right-click and select “repeat” listed at the top (especially useful too if you actually launched a menu macro and not just a single command). or turn on fast right-clicking in OPTIONS and simply “fast right-click” to repeat the last command.

Best answer for this question, how do you repeat last command?

You asked, which command is used to repeat the commands? Repeat command is used for executing the same set of commands a specified number of time.

Considering this, what key is repeat the last command? To repeat the last action in a Microsoft Office program, press the F4 key or Ctrl + Y on a Windows keyboard.

## How do you copy a command in AutoCAD?

1. Select the copy icon from the ribbon panel.
2. Select the objects.
3. After the selection is completed, press Enter.
4. Specify the displacement or base point.

## How do I repeat the last command in Autocad?

You can repeat the command that was last used, or select from a list of recently used commands. Right-click in the drawing, and click Repeat [Last Command].

## Which command is used to re execute the previous command?

Just press the Ctrl and P keys together to fill the prompt with the last executed command and you are ready to go.

## What is the format of repeat command?

The syntax of the REPEAT command is: REPEAT {int|ALL|WHILE condition|UNTIL condition} [counter [/fmt] = init\_expr;] [;] command . . . ENDREPEAT [counter[/fmt]=increment\_expr;] Specifies the number of times the REPEAT loop is to run.

## What function key repeats the last task?

You can repeat your last action by either using the shortcuts "F4 or Ctrl + Y or by adding the Repeat Command on your Quick Access Toolbar. Keyboard shortcuts can save you heaps of time when working with Excel data.

## Which key is used to reuse the last used tools?

The enter key is the default keyboard shortcut to "SOLIDWORKS Repeat Last Command".

## How do I use previous command in AutoCAD?

Early users of AutoCAD would right click their mouse and immediately the last command would be repeated, these days, a right click launches an options menu that includes the option to select the last command, 2 clicks.

## **What will you press to end the sequence of a line as it automatically repeats itself and keeps prompting for additional points?**

After you specify the next point, the LINE command automatically repeats itself, and it keeps prompting you for additional points. Press Enter or the Spacebar to end the sequence.

## **What is mirror command?**

The mirror command in AutoCAD is used to create a copy (mirror copy) of the selected object. We can also delete the source object after mirroring the object. The objects that represent the same as the half of their object can be mirrored across a center line to create the other half of the object.

## **What is difference between mirror and copy command in AutoCAD?**

From what I could tell, copies of the same component act like "clones", whilst mirrored parts seem to be entirely new entities (having unique name), yet they will be affected by some commands, like Press Pull or editing the dimensions of the sketch, but unaffected by others like Extrude, or performing supplementary

## **What is repeat commands?**

The Repeat command lets you reapply the previously applied effect or correction without having to re-access the corresponding dialog box. The last command that can be repeated is always displayed in the Edit menu. If the previous command cannot be repeated, the Repeat command is unavailable.

## **How do you right click in AutoCAD?**

Type options into the command line to open the Options dialogue box. Select the User Preferences tab from the top. In the Windows Standard Behaviour sections, tick the Shortcut menus in drawing area. Select the Right-click Customization and select the Shortcut Menu for the three options, or whatever else you want.

## How do you use the last command?

How to Use the last Command. The syntax for the last command is as follows: last [OPTIONS] [USER] [â€¦] Each time a user logs into the system, a record for that session is written to the /var/log/wtmp file.
