



# When i save in autocad is command line?

## Introduction

1. Select the Save as option from the File menu in **AutoCAD** or F/X CAD.
2. Open the Tools menu in the top right corner of the **Save** Drawing As dialog box. Select Options from the menu.
3. Select your chosen file format from the Save all drawings as menu (example: AutoCAD 2018 Drawing).

People ask also, how do I fix AutoCAD save as problem? Sometimes it gets very annoying while we want to do “Save As” in our AutoCAD file and a prompt popout to enter the file format as shown in the given image. The solution is to type FILEDIA in your **command line** and press enter. Type number 1 and press enter. Issue resolved!

Best answer for this question, what does the **Save** command do in **AutoCAD**? Saves the current drawing under a different file name or location without changing which drawing file is the current one.

In this regard, how do you turn off dynamic input in AutoCAD?

1. Press the F12 key to toggle Dynamic Input on and off.
2. Change the DYNMODE variable to 1 for on, or 0 for off.
3. Toggle the dynamic input icon in the lower-left or lower-right corner of the program:

Also the question is, how do I change my save settings? Open the Settings app. Click on System and then on "Storage" from the side-bar on the left. Scroll down to the bottom of the page, where it says "More Storage Settings". Click on the text that reads "Change where new content is saved".

## How do I save in AutoCAD?

1. On [File] menu, click [Export] " [Export to DXF File] / [Export to DWG File]. [Export] dialog box will be displayed.
2. Select a saving location.
3. Enter a file name in [File Name] box.
4. Click [Save] button. The drawing created in RootPro CAD will be saved as an AutoCAD drawing file.

## How do I reset AutoCAD to default settings?

From the AutoCAD menu, click Preferences. In Preferences, click the Application tab. Click the Reset Application Options button. Click Reset AutoCAD.

## How do I enable command line in AutoCAD?

Use the shortcut CTRL+9 (CMD+3 in AutoCAD for Mac) to toggle on the command line. Type in the `COMMANDLINE` command. It may be necessary to enable Dynamic Input to do this see How to enable or disable dynamic input in AutoCAD: Right-click on either Dynamic input or Object Snap in the Status Bar and select Settings.

## How do I know if my AutoCAD file is corrupted?

1. Drawing file does not open.
2. Drawing file opens with errors.
3. File hangs or crashes AutoCAD.
4. Slow performance when editing a file.
5. Error messages appear when working in a file.
6. Commands do not work or are delayed.
7. Unexplained increase in file size.

## What is command line in AutoCAD?

The command line is where you will see instructions and options when using commands. For example, on the Home ribbon, in the Draw panel, click the Line tool. On the command line, the program prompts you to specify the first point of the line. Once you click to pick that point, the prompt changes.

## How do I turn off commands in AutoCAD?

You can run the UNDO command in any localized version of AutoCAD by typing `_UNDO` in the commandline.

## How do I disable a command in AutoCAD?

Not many users and CAD managers know that in AutoCAD you can disable (undefine) internal commands. For disabling a required command use the `_UNDEFINE` command followed by name of the undefined command.

## What is dynamic input command?

The command that we type on the command line or command prompt is also reflected in the command interface near the cursor known as Dynamic Input. It is considered as an alternative way to enter the commands. The information on the tooltip is the updated information of a specified command.

## How do I change the destination of a file?

## How do I change the default save settings in Word?

From the Word menu, select Preferences. In the Preferences window, click Save. From the menu next to "Save Word files as:", select the format you want as the default.

## How do I make the default save to my desktop?

Click the "Save" tab in the left-hand pane. Under the "Save Documents" section, check the box next to "Save to Computer by Default". Finally, click the "Ok" button in the bottom-right corner of the window to apply the change. Now, the next time you save an Office file, your computer will be the default save location.

## How do I save a line in AutoCAD?

If the selected source is Objects, click Select Objects, and in the drawing area select objects to save. Specify or pick a base point, if desired. Enter a file name and path and change the units, as needed, and click OK.

## How do you save a drawing?

1. Open a drawing to save.
2. Click File > Save As > Export. The Export Setup dashboard opens.
3. Select TIFF in the Configure group.
4. Click Export. The Save a Copy dialog box opens.

5. Under New file name, type the required new file name.
6. From the Type list, select TIFF.
7. Click OK.
8. Click Yes when prompted. The file is created.

## How do I save a selected object in AutoCAD?

Select Tools and then Options from the upper-right menu. Click the DXF Options tab in the Save As dialog box. Select the Select Objects check box and click OK. In the Save Drawing As dialog box, enter a name and location for the file, and then click Save.

## How do I change settings in AutoCAD?

1. Click Application button > Options.
2. In the Options dialog box, click a tab and set options as desired.
3. Save the settings: To save the settings and keep working in the dialog box, click Apply.
