

Why is crop view greyed out in revit?

Description

Correspondingly, how do I change crop view in Revit?

1. In a plan, elevation, or section view, select a **crop** region and click Edit Modify | tab Mode panel Edit Crop.
2. Use the tools on the Modify and Draw panels to edit the **crop** region as needed.
3. When you are finished, click Finish Edit Mode.

Also know, can you crop drafting views in **Revit**? Note: Crop Regions should not be used with drafting views, and this option has been disabled in the **View** Control Bar. However, a **crop** can be enabled using a keyboard shortcut..

Additionally, where is the size crop tool in **Revit**? In the drawing area, select the **crop** region. Click Modify tab Crop panel (Size Crop). The Crop Region Size dialog opens. If you are modifying a **crop** region in a perspective 3D **view**, select either Field of view or Scale (locked proportions).

Best answer for this question, why is scope box **greyed** out Revit? There are some situations where the Scope Box property of a view is greyed **out** " so you cannot assign a Scope Box to the **view**. The answer may be to do with the Crop Boundary " and it may not be obvious, especially if the crop boundary is hidden.

How do I crop a viewport in sheet?

1. Select the viewport.
2. Select the command.
3. Click Crop to enter Edit Crop mode.
4. Create a 2D object such as a rectangle, circle, or polyline.
5. Click Exit Viewport Crop to return to the sheet layer or design layer.
6. The cropped viewport displays; in the Object Info palette, the Crop status changes to Yes.

How do you crop an image in Revit?

1. if from Insert Image (for Plan Views) , use a Mask: Annotate > Detail > Region > Masking Region (or a solid white Filled Region) with Invisible Lines as borders.
2. if you use Decal (for 3d renderings), then the borders of the face of the object on which the Decal is applied will crop the Decal..

How do you crop a drawing on a sheet in Revit?

How do you clip a view in Revit?

1. In the Project Browser, select the plan view you want to cut by the back clip plane.
2. On the Properties palette, under Extents, find the Depth Clipping parameter.
3. Click the button in the value column.
4. In the Depth Clipping dialog, select an option and click OK.

What is Revit annotation crop?

The annotation crop area can be used to crop tags, text, dimensions or other annotative elements separately from the model crop region.

How do I turn off annotation cropping in Revit?

After you show crop regions, if the annotation crop region is hidden, right-click in the drawing area, and click View Properties. On the Properties palette, select (or clear) the check box for Annotation Crop.

How do you crop a scope box in Revit?

How do you activate a scope box in Revit?

1. In a plan view, click View tab Create panel (Scope Box).
2. On the Options Bar, enter a name and specify a height for the scope box, if desired.
3. To draw a scope box, click in the upper left-hand corner to start the box.

Can you crop a PDF in Revit?

You can use any shape for the crop border, not just rectangular trimming (see the Edit Profile context ribbon). Then use the cropped raster image (view) on your drawing sheet.

How do you zoom in a viewport in Revit?

1. Zoom in Region “Click twice to define a rectangle.

2. Zoom Out (2X) – View is zoomed so elements are half the size they were before the view was zoomed out.
3. Zoom to Fit – View is zoomed to the maximum extents of elements visible in the view.

How do I crop a view?

1. In a drawing view, sketch a closed profile such as a circle.
2. Click Crop View. (Drawing toolbar), or click Insert > Drawing View > Crop. The view outside the profile disappears. A circle is drawn on this Section View. After cropping, only the view inside the circle is displayed.

How do I resize a sheet view in Revit?

Right-click the activated view, and click Pan Active View. Drag the cursor to pan the view. Change the scale of the view. On the View Control Bar, for Scale, select the desired scale.

How do you edit a viewport on a sheet in Revit?

1. Open the sheet.
2. In the drawing area, select a view on the sheet.
3. Click Modify | Viewports tab Viewport panel (Activate View).
4. Modify the view as desired.
5. To deactivate the view on the sheet, double-click outside of the view, or right-click, and click Deactivate View.

How do you cut a section in Revit?

You can break section lines by clicking the break control and adjusting the length of the section line segments. The section break is in the middle of the section line. The following images show the same section, whole and broken. To rejoin the section line, click the break control again.

How do you cut a 3d view in Revit?

What does crop region mean?

The crop region defines the boundaries for a project view. You can display a model crop region and an annotation crop region in all graphical project views.

How do you resize annotation crops in Revit?

1. In the drawing area, select the crop region.

2. Click Modify tab Crop panel (Size Crop).
3. If you are modifying a crop region in a perspective 3D view, select either Field of view or Scale (locked proportions).

Where is the view control bar in Revit?

The View Control Bar is located at the bottom of the view window above the status bar and includes the following tools: Note: The exact tools available on the View Control Bar depends on the view type. Show/Hide Rendering Dialog (Available only when the drawing area displays a 3D view.)

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
