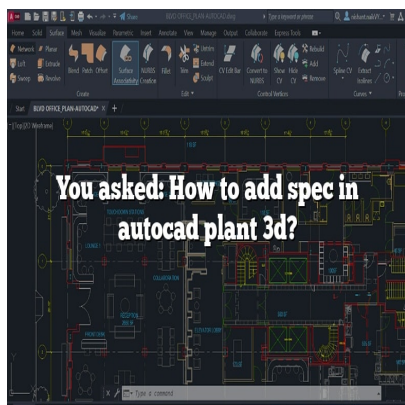

2. In the Create Spec dialog box, under Spec Name, click the  button and browse to the folder where you want to save the spec file. 
3. In the Spec Description box, enter a description.
4. Optional.
5. Click Create.

Take a look at the Create Equipment tool. From the ribbon, Home tab, Equipment panel, click Create. The Create Equipment dialog appears. All of the project's class definitions are listed in the drop-down list.

AutoCAD P ID software allows you to create, modify, and manage schematic piping and instrumentation diagrams. AutoCAD Plant 3D adds 3D models, including piping, equipment, support structures, generation of isometric, and orthographic drawings. AutoCAD Plant 3D includes the features of AutoCAD P ID.

Is AutoCAD plant 3D included in AutoCAD?

The 2023 Plant 3D toolset is included with AutoCAD. Create and edit P&IDs and 3D models, and extract piping orthographics and isometrics with an industry-specific toolset for plant design.

How do I create a new catalog in Plant 3D?

1. Open the catalog in the Catalog Editor.
2. Select the component in the Catalog Editor which you want to modify.
3. Select in menu "Catalog > Modify Catalog Properties".

4. Fill the fields here.
5. Save the component to the catalog.

How do you load CADWorx equipment in plants?

To load CADWorx Equipment into CADWorx Plant, we will need to edit the C:\CADWorx 2010\PlantSupport\acad.rx, and add a line to load the CADWorx Equipment arx file, and then we will need to add a support file search path to the Support folder for CADWorx Equipment.

How do you get mechanical in AutoCAD?

AutoCAD Mechanical subscriptions can be purchased on a monthly, yearly or 3 yearly terms, and AutoCAD Mechanical is also available as part of the Autodesk Product Design Collection and part of AutoCAD with specialised toolsets.

How do you make a 3d structure in AutoCAD?

1. If necessary, on the status bar click Workspace Switching and select 3D Modeling. Find.
2. Click Solid tab > Solid panel > Extrude. Find.
3. Select the objects or edge subobjects to extrude.
4. Specify the height.

How do I delete a nozzle in AutoCAD 3d?

1. Select the nozzle and click the pencil to edit the nozzle.
2. Switch to tab "Locate nozzle" and click the link "Remove".

How do you create a plant in AutoCAD?

1. Open the Insert dialog box and click on the Browse button.
2. Browse through the collection until you find the block of trees or plants that you want to insert.
3. Use the dialog box settings in the same way you would for a block within your drawing.
4. The last step is very important.

How do I insert a P&ID symbol in AutoCAD?

1. Click Schematic tab Insert Components panel Insert P&ID Components.
2. In the Insert Component: Piping and Instrumentation Symbols dialog box, click Equipment.
3. In the PID: Equipment dialog box, click Ball Mill.
4. Respond to the prompts as follows:

How do I open a P&ID file in AutoCAD?

1. Open a Plant 3D model.
2. On the ribbon, click Home tab Part Insertion panel P&ID Line List.
3. In the P&ID Line List window, in the drop-down list, click the P&ID drawing you want to open.

Where is P&ID in AutoCAD?

Click the [Schematic] tab > [Insert Components] panel > [Insert P&ID Components]. To add equipment, in the [Insert Components] > [Piping and Instrumentation Symbols] dialog box, click equipment. Repeat steps of insertion as required.
