Select the rasters to fit (via the Raster Manager dialog box or graphically, using the Select Rasters tool). Select the Fit to View tool. Set Mode to Selected Rasters. Select the view(s) to fit.

Did you know that you can rotate an isometric view in 90 degree increments by using the following Key-Ins; For a Clockwise rotation key-in: RV=-54.5,-54.5,-90 and select the view for rotation, for a Counter-Clockwise rotation key-in: RV=-54.5,54.5,90 and select the appropriate view.

How do I open 3D in MicroStation?

1. Open 2 windows in MicroStation IE window 1 will leave as 2d window 2 will set to 3D)
2. open the view attributes on window2 (top left corner of the window)
3. Expand the view set up and set the model and change the model to the managed 3D view (IE Default-3D)

Answer: With an alignment loaded in InRoads, a line can be placed using the key-in so (for station offset). Key-in the station comma the offset, i.e. (100+00,-50).

How do I hide the element in my Bentley View?

Simply right click on an element and select Hide in View. That element is then hidden.

How do I view a clip in MicroStation?

Use the Element Selection tool to select the elements about which clipping is required. Select the Clip Volume view control. In the tool settings, click the Apply Clip Volume By Element Range icon. Accept in the view to which you want clipping applied.

How do you unlock raster images in MicroStation?

To release the lock, ensure the image is selected and press CTRL+M or choose Edit > Unlock. 2) Lock the level. Since raster attachments are put on a level, you can also lock the level via the Level Manager.

What is nesting depth in MicroStation?

Nesting. When a MicroStation design file used as a reference has its own attachments, they become nested references. The links between these files can be maintained through many levels (depths) of nesting, so that if you open only one file, you can view the contents of many files.

How do you pan in MicroStation?

In MicroStation V8 XM Edition, you can pan with your mouse by simply holding down the middle wheel/button on your mouse.

How do I Print my Bentley View?

To print exactly what you see in your view to paper, launch the Print dialog by clicking the Print icon on the Quick Access Toolbar in the title bar of Bentley View CONNECT. (Or type Ctrl+P or select File > Print>Print).
