Introduction

Best answer for this question, how do you use construction lines in **Fusion** 360?

As many you asked, what shortcut key changes a **line** to from construction geometry in Fusion 360? To do so, simply hold down the shift key and select all the lines that you want to **change**. Then you can hit the keyboard shortcut letter "X" or select "construction" in the Sketch dialog box. You'll notice that construction lines are signified by dashed lines.

Likewise, what is line command in Fusion 360? You may be wondering if Fusion 360 has a command **line** similar to AutoCAD. A command-line interface processes lines of text for a computer program. The command-line is not to be confused with **Fusion** 360's line command, which is a tool used to create linear lines.

Also, how do you make different shapes in Fusion 360?

1. To create a new design, click the + tab. This creates a new tab for your design.
2. To open the Sketch command, click Solid (tab) > Create > Create Sketch.
3. You are now prompted to select a plane to sketch on. To do this, select the "Top" (XY) plane.

How do you make a diagonal line in Fusion 360?

How do I change the sketch plane in Fusion 360?

1. Right clicking the sketch icon in the timeline.
2. Click Redefine Sketch Plane.
3. Re-select the geometry reference to use as the new sketch plane.
4. Click OK.

Where is the line tool in Fusion 360?

The Line tool in the Sketch > Create panel lets you create a connected series of lines and arcs as sketch geometry or construction geometry in an active sketch in Fusion 360. You can use the following command to create lines in an active sketch: Line.

What do blue lines mean in Fusion 360?

Note: Notice that the lines on the arc are blue, where as all the other lines are black. This is because a black line means it has been fully defined whereas a blue line means it has not. 14) Go to **SKETCH** then **Arc** and select the **3-Point Arc** tool.

How do I change Keybinds on Fusion 360?

1. Find a command in your toolbar. Even look for commands in other workspaces.
2. Once you find your command, hover for a second, then hit the three vertical dots (shown below).
3. Pick your favorite key or combo of keys to set as your new custom keyboard shortcut.

What are the shortcut keys for Fusion 360?

1. Animate Workspace Commands. U.
2. CAM Workspace Commands. Ctrl + D | Command +D.
3. Canvas Selection. Ctrl + C | Command + C.
4. Drawing Workspace Commands. B.
5. Edit Form Commands. Alt + Drag.
6. Generative Design workspace. N.
7. Render Workspace Commands. A.
8. Sculpt Workspace Selection. Shift + Up Arrow.

How do I get design shortcuts in Fusion 360?

1. In the toolbar, select the command you want to create a custom shortcut for.
2. Hover over the right side of the command until you see the vertical ellipsis icon (i.e., three vertical dots).
3. Click the virtual ellipsis icon, then select **Change keyboard shortcut**.

How do we use the line command?

1. Open the AutoCAD software.
2. Select the Line icon from the ribbon panel or type L or Line and press Enter on the command line.
3. Specify the starting point and endpoint using the cursor on the workspace or drawing area, as shown in the below image:
4. Press Enter or Esc to exit.

What is the use of line command?

The command line is a text interface for your computer. It's a program that takes in commands, which it passes on to the computer's operating system to run. From the command line, you can navigate through files and folders on your computer, just as you would with Windows Explorer on Windows or Finder on Mac OS.

How do I use the line tool in AutoCAD?

1. Click Home tab > Draw panel > Line. Find.
2. Specify the start point and end point of the line segment by clicking in the drawing area.
3. Continue specifying additional line segments.
4. Press Enter or Esc when done or enter c to close a series of line segments.

How do you make a rectangle in Fusion 360?

The Center Rectangle command creates a rectangle defined by the center point and one corner point. You click to place the first point as the center of the rectangle, then click to place a corner point or specify width and height values.

Can you type in Fusion 360?

It allows users to quickly input letters and text directly from the keyboard instead of having to manually trace them, one at a time. With Fusion 360 open in the Design Workspace, you can create a new sketch. Go to the "Text" feature that's found under the "Create" menu at the "Sketch" ribbon.

What are purple lines in Fusion 360?

Purple is Projected. To edit them, you have to break the link to the original. If the second sketch has a dimension to the edge of the body, Fusion has projected that purple line in for the dimension to make sense.
