- 1. Open file A.
- 2. Save as C.
- 3. Delete the model in the C file. All you want to keep are the scenes.
- 4. Use **File** â€"> Import to import the model from **file** B.
- 5. Save as B, overwriting old file B with a new **one** that inherited all the scenes from A.

You asked, can you copy a scene in SketchUp to another file? One option would be to use Save asâ€l to create a new file with the scenes. Then delete your old model content and paste in the new. You might also have a look at Eneroth3's collection of extensions in the Extension Warehouse. She's got one that copies views, which mihai.

Quick Answer, how do you duplicate a scene in **SketchUp**? Select the scene you want to make other scenes to match. In the scene manager highlight this same scene, then select all the scenes you want to be the same (Shift for multiple Cntl for individual) deselect the ""Camera Location†in the properties to save area, then reselect the camera location. DO NOT HIT UPDATE.

Beside above, how do I import a scene from SketchUp to LayOut?

- 1. In LayOut, right-click on a model viewport and choose Open with **SketchUp** from the context menu.
- 2. In SketchUp, use the navigation tools to frame the view you want.
- 3. Add a new **scene** to your model (View > Animation > Add Scene).
- 4. Save your model.

Additionally, how do I export one scene in **SketchUp**? Select File > Export > Animation > Image Set. In the Export Animation dialog box, select where you want SketchUp to save your images. Select the Move tool () from the toolbar or press M. The cursor changes to a four-way arrow. To tell SketchUp that you want to duplicate the selected entities, tap the Ctrl (Microsoft Windows) or Option (macOS) key to toggle **Copy** functionality. A plus sign appears next to the four-way arrow cursor.

How do you copy and paste a component in SketchUp?

How do I export views from SketchUp?

Select File > Export > 2D Graphic. The Export 2D Graphic dialog box appears. Navigate to the location where you want to save your image. (Optional) In the File Name box, type a name for your image file.

How do I export a section from SketchUp to LayOut?

- 1. In SketchUp, click the Send to Layout button. The LayOut application opens.
- 2. Select a LayOut template for your document. Your model opens in LayOut as a Sketchup viewport.

Can you export multiple scenes in SketchUp?

Provided you have the checkbox "include in animation†checked in the scenes window for the scenes you wish to export. You can go to FILE>EXPORT>ANIMATION>IMAGE SET. You have several file types to choose to save the scenes as, including JPEG.

How do you save multiple SketchUp scenes as a JPEG?

- Go to Window -> Model Info -> Animation -> uncheck the Scence Transitions box.
- 2. Go to the File menu -> Export -> Animation, set the file type to JPEG.
- 3. Use the Options button to adjust the size of the images.
- 4. Export animation.

How do you make scenes in SketchUp?

1. Select Window > Scenes to open the Scenes manager.

- 2. Click the Add Scene icon (+)
- 3. The scene appears in the Scenes manager with the default name "Scene 1â€. To rename the scene, click the Show Details icon in the upper right of the Scenes manager, then rename the scene and add a description.

Can you copy and paste in SketchUp?

Choose Edit > Copy from the menu or use a shortcut – either Ctrl+C for Windows or Command+C for a Mac. Next choose Edit > Paste from the menu bar, Ctrl+V for Windows or Command+V for a Mac – and you'II see the cursor change into a Move tool. The SketchUp components you've copied float around as you move the mouse.

How do you make multiple copies of an object in SketchUp?

Discussion. To make copies, activate the Move tool and press the Ctrl key (Option on the Mac). SketchUp is very flexible in how you can set the spacing and number of copies: After the first copy is made, you can enter the number of copies you want and set the spacing between them.

How do you copy and paste offset in SketchUp?

Double-click on another face element to copy the procedure and apply an offset of the same amount to this element. Repeat this procedure for each face element for which you want to repeat the offset.

How do you copy a layer in SketchUp?

- 1. Make the selection.
- 2. Copy.
- 3. Move the selection to the new layer.
- 4. Turn off the new layer if you like (optional, but gives you visual confirmation)
- 5. Paste in place.

Can you push pull multiple surfaces in SketchUp?

If we want to extrude (push/pull) a lot of faces the same distance, we might use the default SketchUp Push Pull tool, but it might take very long if we have a lot of faces. By default, if we push one face and then double click on different one, the new one will be push/pulled the same distance.

How do you copy paint in SketchUp?

Just pick up as usual by holding Alt in Paint Bucket tool and then apply to other faces. Both positioning and material is copied.

Can SketchUp export STEP files?

You need to export the sketchup file as a STI, then import and convert the mesh to a shape with freecad. Once complete, you can export the shape as a . STEP file.

How do I export in SketchUp?

In SketchUp, select File > Export > 3D Model. The Export Model dialog box appears. Navigate to the location where you want to save your exported file. (Optional) Change the file name if you like.

What file types can SketchUp export?

- 1. Your SketchUp Pro subscription comes with professional-level interoperability.
- 2. SketchUp Export: SKP, 3DS, DAE, DWG, DXF, FBX, IFC, OBJ, KMZ, STL, WRL, XSI, JPG, PNG, TIF, PDF (Mac Only), EPS.

How do you explode in SketchUp?

To explode an entity, select it, context-click the selection, and choose Explode Curve from the menu that appears. In the figure, you see a polygon that's about to explode into its individual segments.

Can you group scenes SketchUp?

I might suggest that Sketchup developers do something like this: Either the user manually groups scenes, or as is my preference, scenes are automatically grouped according to the scene name. So scenes with the same prefix, (text before a hyphen "-â€) would be grouped together.

How do I copy a LayOut from one drawing to another?

- 1. Open the drawing that you want to import a layout into.
- 2. Right click on a layout tab.
- Select "From Templateâ€.
- 4. Change the Files of type to "Drawing (*.
- 5. Browse to the drawing that you want to import the layout tab from.
- 6. Select the Layout(s) from the Insert Layout(s) dialog.
- 7. Select OK.
