1. Import an **image** into **LayOut**. In the File menu, select the Insert
2. Draw a clipping shape. Next, draw a shape for clipping, our image.
3. Create a clipping mask.
4. Scale and position the cropped image.
5. Other cool stuff.
6. Try it with a Google **SketchUp** model.

Frequent question, how do I resize an **image** in **SketchUp** LayOut? Select Window > Scaled Drawing. In the Scaled Drawing panel that appears, click Make Scaled Drawing. Choose a scale. (Optional) From the Length drop-down list, choose Decimal, Architectural, Engineering, or Fractional.

Also the question is, how do you cut a **LayOut** in SketchUp?

Additionally, how do you insert a picture into SketchUp LayOut?

1. Select File > Insert. An Open dialog box appears.
2. Navigate to the image file on your hard drive.
3. Select the file you want to insert, as shown in the following figure, and click Open.

With your benchmark selected, hold down the Shift key and scale it until it snaps to the right endpoint of your line. As long as you hold down Shift, your selection should scale proportionately.

How do you scale a drawing in layout?

1. Select the layout viewport that you want to modify.
2. Right-click, and then choose Properties.
3. If necessary, click Display Locked and choose No.
4. In the Properties palette, select Standard Scale, and then select a new scale from the list.

Can I crop an image in SketchUp?

Create a clipping mask. Once you have the rectangle in the right location, you're ready to make it a clipping mask. First, select both the image and the clipping rectangle. Now, in the Edit menu, select Create Clipping Mask. Voilà , a cropped image.

How do I cut a section in LayOut?

1) Activate one of the Section Cut scenes by clicking its Scene Tab. 2) Apply the Sections style by choosing it from the Select Tab in the Styles Manager. 3) Right-click the current Scene Tab and choose Update Scene. 4) Repeat Steps 1 to 3 for each of your other Section Cut scenes.

How do I make a clipping mask in SketchUp?

1. Place a shape over an image or model, as shown in the following figure.
2. Select both the shape and the image or model.
3. Context-click the selection and choose Create Clipping Mask from the context menu that appears. Your image or model is then masked, as shown in the following figure.

To edit your material, just right click on the material and select Edit Texture Image from the Context menu that appears. This will open your image editing software, in this case Photoshop.

1. In the Colors panel, click the Textures Palette tab (the one with the brick icon).
2. Select the collection where you want the new material to appear.

3. Select Color > New Texture.
4. In the dialog box that appears, select an image file for your texture.

Why is my viewport scale not accurate?

Causes: The following could cause the incorrect scale: The layout is corrupt. Page Setup scale is not set correctly.

Whatever you're trying to model, here's how to start tracing an image: Import your image into SketchUp by selecting File > Import. Then navigate to and select the image you want to import. If you don't see the image you're looking for, make sure the correct file type is selected (such as JPG or PNG).

How do I use PNG in SketchUp?

By default, the image file has the same name as your SketchUp model. From the Format drop-down list, select a raster file type. The raster options are JPEG, PNG, or TIFF. (Optional) Click the Options button to open the options dialog box for your selected file type.
