## Introduction

Select the Clip Mask view control. In the tool settings, click the Show or Hide Clip Mask Element icon.

People ask also, how do I remove a clipping mask in Photoshop?

1. Hold down Alt (Option in Mac OS), position the pointer over the line separating two grouped layers in the Layers panel (the pointer changes to two overlapping circles), and click.
2. In the Layers panel, select a layer in the clipping **mask**, and choose Layer > Release Clipping **Mask**.

Additionally, how do I remove a mask in Illustrator?

1. Select Object > Clipping Mask > Edit/Release.

2. Or edit by isolating the clipping mask: double click it or find it on the Layers Panel.

## How do I delete a reference in Microstation?

You can Detach All References using a key-in "Reference Detach All" after you are in a file or use the key-in in a Batch Process or in a Macro that is run when you open a file.

## How do I cut an image in MicroStation?

1. In the Raster Control tool box, select the Clip tool.
2. In the tool settings, set Method to Block and Mode to Clip Boundary.
3. If more than one raster image is attached, identify the image to be clipped.
4. Place a data point to define the first point of the clipping block.

## How do you add a background to text in MicroStation?

You can use a Text Style to apply a background color to text. To do this, modify an existing Text Style or create a new one (from menu Element > Text Styles). Then turn on the background colour by going to the Background tab in Text Styles (see image 1 below). Save the Text Style.

## How do I go to front in MicroStation?

MicroStation V8 2004 Edition " Use Edit > Bring to Front 07.24 and later, you can change the element order by first creating a selection set of the elements you want to bring to the front and then selecting Edit > Bring to Front. To make it even easier, just put order element front on a function key and away you go!

## How do I remove the outline from a clipping mask in Illustrator?

## Can you release all clipping masks in Illustrator?

You don't need a script to release all clipping mask in one step, just do: Select->Object->Clipping Mask. Edit->Clear.

## How do I remove a mask from a PDF image?

Infix Pro PDF Editor Click on the object you wish to "pop" from it's clipping mask. Choose Object->Clipping Mask->Remove From Clip.

## How do you release a mask in Indesign?

To release a clipping path in ID, select the placed image and choose Object > Clipping Path > Options. Then from the Path dropdown menu you find in the dialog box, choose None.

## What is the difference between layer mask and clipping mask?

Clipping masks allow you to hide portions of an image, but these masks are created using multiple layers, whereas layer masks only make use of a single layer. A clipping mask is a shape that masks other artwork and only reveals what lies in shape.

## How do you edit references in MicroStation?

In MicroStation go with the cursor on a element of the reference file, which you want to edit, right mouse click and select "Activate". The reference file will become the active file; the master file is inactive and grayed out. You can edit the elements of the reference file in the same MicroStation dialogue.

Non-Referenced Files: Merge via a keyin: MicroStation is delivered with a beast called merge.ma which can be used to merge elements from one design file into another.

## How do you edit a raster image in MicroStation?

To modify a selected raster image Use the Select Rasters tool, or the Raster Manager dialog box, to select the raster image file to modify. Select the Modify Raster tool. Make the required changes to the settings in the settings window. Identify a handle, or arrow, and drag it to modify the image graphically.
