Millions of engineers and designers in tens of thousands of companies use Sketchup. It is one of the most widely used design and engineering programs and is used by many different professions and companies around the world because of its wide range of features and excellent functionality.

Introduction

1. With your model open in SketchUp, select Window > Model Info.
2. In the sidebar on the left, select Units. The Units panel appears.
3. From the Format drop-down list, select your desired unit format: Architectural, Decimal, Engineering, or Fractional.

Moreover, how do I **enter** Measurements in SketchUp? Type a length value, a comma, a width value, and then press Enter. For example, type 8'20" and press Enter. If you type only a number or numbers, **SketchUp** uses the current document units setting. You can also override the document units setting by specifying imperial (such as 1'6") or metric (such as 3.652m) units.

Subsequently, how do I input inches in SketchUp?

You asked, how do you write Measurements in SketchUp?

1. Open **SketchUp**, then click the toolbar's "Line" tool.
2. Drag a short distance.
3. Type 40' to extend the line to 40 **feet**.
4. Type 40" to shrink the line to 40 **inches**.
5. Press Enter to finish the line.

As many you asked, how do I set metric units in SketchUp? In **SketchUp** Desktop: You can change units in SketchUp (desktop) by going to Window > Model Info > Units. This will automatically change all of the dimensions in the model to match. You can also change units and create default templates within SketchUp. You can only type in a measurement while you're drawing, regardless of which version of **SketchUp** you're using. For example, if I want to draw a line that's specifically 3' long, I would use the line tool, click a starting point and before I click an end point, I would type 3' and then

hit **enter**.

Where is the measurement box in SketchUp?

Go to View>Toolbars. Is Measurements checked? If so, uncheck it. Also make sure the SketchUp window is maximized so none of it is running off the bottom of the screen.

How do you change feet in SketchUp?

You can change the measurement units in SketchUp by going to Window > Model Info > Units. Choose a preset like Architectural, Engineering, or Fractional. Or if you want to customize your units, choose Decimal to pick any metric or imperial unit for length, area, and volume.

How do I change units in layout?

1. Click the Tools menu and click Options.
2. Click the Layout View tab.
3. Adjust Page units to the desired unit. The status bar displays the pointer position in the chosen units.
4. Click OK.

How do I draw a rectangle with specific dimensions in SketchUp?

Start the Rectangle tool, click to set the first corner and then drag out to make a rectangle. Type the dimensions you want and hit Enter. This is a very basic operation. You should look at the tutorial videos available at sketchup.com and learn how the program works.

How do you change measurements in SketchUp for schools?

1. In SketchUp for Schools, click the Open Model/Preferences icon (
2. On the panel that appears, click the Model Info icon (

3. On the Model Info panel that appears, select an option in the Format area.
4. In the Precision area, select your desired level of precision.

How do you change the length of a line in SketchUp?

1. Select the Move tool ().
2. Hover the Move tool cursor over one of the line's end points.
3. Click and drag the end point to change the line's length.

How do I scale a reference in SketchUp?

Scale in SketchUp the Easy Way. Measure. Triple click on one of the faces of your cube to select the entire shape. Select the tape measure tool and measure the edge you want to change the dimensions of by clicking once at the starting point and once at the end.

How do I change the units in SketchUp LayOut Mac?

1. From the Format drop-down list, select Fractional or Decimal.
2. Select a unit of measurement, such as inches, feet, or meters, from the second Format drop-down list.
3. From the Precision drop-down list, select how precise you want the units to be.

How do I change the LayOut in SketchUp?

To change a model entity's style settings in LayOut, follow these steps: Select the SketchUp model entity in the drawing area. Open the SketchUp Model panel and select the Styles tab. By default, you see the In Model styles, which are the styles saved with the SketchUp model file.

How do I manually input dimensions in SketchUp?

How do you scale dimensions?

To scale an object to a smaller size, you simply divide each dimension by the required scale factor. For example, if you would like to apply a scale factor of 1:6 and the length of the item is 60 cm, you simply divide $60 / 6 = 10$ cm to get the new dimension.

Where is scale in SketchUp?

The SketchUp Scale Tool Take a look at the top toolbar and you'll see it, a red square with a brown box in the left hand corner and a red arrow pointing off towards the right hand corner. Maybe you want to scale a single face of an object.

How do I change page size in LayOut?

1. Click the Layout tab.
2. Click the Size button.
3. Select the size you want to use. If the size you want to use doesn't appear in the list, select More Paper Sizes. The Paper tab of the Page Setup dialog box appears, where you can enter a custom paper size.

How do I change the LayOut template?

How do I change page size in SketchUp LayOut?

Just go to File>Document Setup>Paper and change the size. The content on the page will appear to be in the upper left corner of the sheet so you'll need to move and adjust things to suit.
