1. Open the model into which you want to import a **SketchUp** file.
2. Select File > Import.
3. In the Open dialog box that appears, navigate to the **SketchUp** file.
4. Select the SketchUp file, and click Open.
5. Click in the drawing area to place the component in your model.

1. Select the geometry you want to include in your component.
2. Choose Edit > Make Component from the menu bar, or context-click the selection and choose Make **Component**.
3. In the Definition box, type a meaningful name for your **component**.
4. In the Description box, add a short description of your **component**.

1. Navigate to the page where you want to insert a SketchUp model.
2. Select File > **Insert** from the menu bar.
3. In the Open dialog box that appears, navigate to the SketchUp model file, select it, and click Open. Your **SketchUp** model appears in the document area.

What is the difference between component and group in SketchUp?

By definition, a Group is a single instance of a collection of geometry. A Component is a named collection of geometry that can exist at multiple locations within the model. Each instance is a repetition of all others. A change to one instance changes all other instances.

Can SketchUp do assemblies?

How do you add a component to a group in SketchUp?

Double click on the group, it will open it and you'll be able to modify it. Open the group for edit to add or modify contents.

How do you add a tree in SketchUp?

To add a new tree to your project, click New. The Land F/X Add Plants dialog box will open. Scroll to the Genus of the tree you want to add. Click the genus to select it.

How do you add a 3D Warehouse in SketchUp?

In SketchUp, locate and click the 3D Warehouse icon in the top toolbar and a 3D Warehouse window appears that connects you to the main page, as shown in the following figure. Alternatively, you can open the 3D Warehouse by selecting Window > 3D Warehouse from the menu bar.

Can you import objects into SketchUp?

How do I insert a scene in SketchUp LayOut?

In LayOut, right-click on a model viewport and choose Open with SketchUp from the context menu. In SketchUp, use the navigation tools to frame the view you want. Add a new scene to your model (View > Animation > Add Scene). Save your model.

How do I download SketchUp components?

1. Open the details page for the model whose material you want to download.
2. In the stats panel, click the Materials link.
3. When you find a material, click the Download link.

How do I save a component library in SketchUp?

How do I create a dynamic component in SketchUp?

1. Select the component you want to make dynamic.
2. On the Dynamic Components toolbar, click the Component Attributes tool () or select Window > Component Attributes.
3. Click the Add Attribute plus sign icon to see a list of options.

How do you put furniture on a floor plan?

1. Go to Floor Level or to Room Level.
2. Tap on the "Add" button, and then "Object".
3. Choose the object group that matches your piece of furniture.
4. Tap on a piece of furniture to add it to the plan.
5. Drag and drop any furniture to its correct location.

How do you add 2d furniture in SketchUp?

How do you edit a single component?

Changing a single component instance Select the component instance that you want to edit. Context-click the selected instance and choose Make Unique, as shown in the figure. If you have the Entity Info panel open, you see that SketchUp changes the Definition by adding #1, or something similar.

How do I edit an existing model in SketchUp?

Select the SketchUp model entity, context-click the selection, and choose Edit 3D View from the menu that appears. Or, you can enter Edit 3D View by double-clicking, or selecting the model entity and pressing Enter.

How do I edit 3d Warehouse models in SketchUp?

How do I edit a group component in SketchUp?

To edit a group, double-click the group entity with the Select tool or select it and press Enter. All entities outside the group's context appear faded. If you have nested groups, you can continue double-clicking to open the group that you want to edit.
