2. Camera > Standard Views > Front.
3. Default Tray > Styles > Edit.
4. Edge Settings.
5. Face Settings.
6. Modeling Settings.
7. Shadows.
8. View > Fog.

1. Open a plan view.
2. Click View tab -> Create panel -> Elevation.

3. The cursor appears with the elevation symbol.
4. On the Options Bar, select a view scale.
5. Place the cursor near a wall, and click to place the elevation symbol.

## **What is elevation Layout?**

An elevation drawing is an orthographic projection drawing that shows one side of the house. The purpose of an elevation drawing is to show the finished appearance of a given side of the house and furnish vertical height dimensions. Four elevations are customarily drawn, one for each side of the house.

## **What is the elevation view?**

This is an elevation view. An elevation is a view from the side of an object, when drawing interior elevations, this would represent one of the walls. This would include any windows or doors as well as any built-in furniture that is in direct contact with the wall. This is a section view.

## **What is plan view and elevation view?**

The plan view, or bird's eye view, is the view seen looking down on the object. The elevation view is the view from one side of the object. Engineers and architects also use rough drawings and scaled drawings. Rough drawings are hand drawn drawings that are not drawn to scale.

## **What is architectural elevation?**

In short an architectural elevation is a drawing of an interior or exterior vertical surface or plane, that forms the skin of the building. Drawn in an orthographic view typically drawn to scale, to show the exact size and proportions of the building's features.

The four main types of elevation are: front, side, rear, and split.

## **What are the types of elevation?**

Elevations depict how your home will look when viewed from specific angles. There are different types of elevation with respect to these specific angles. Front elevation, side elevations, rear elevations and split elevations are some types.

## **What are the 4 elevations?**

Elevations show how your property will appear from various perspectives. There are several forms of elevation in relation to these precise angles. Front elevations, side elevations, rear elevations, and split elevations are some examples.

## **How do elevations work?**

Elevation is distance above sea level. Elevations are usually measured in meters or feet. They can be shown on maps by contour lines, which connect points with the same elevation; by bands of color; or by numbers giving the exact elevations of particular points on the Earth's surface.

## **What is the difference between elevation and section?**

The difference between Interior Elevations and Sections is that Interior Elevations start at the finished floor elevation and stop at the ceiling. Interior Elevations show individual walls in specific rooms,

whereas Sections cut through floors showing multiple rooms stacked on top of each other.

## **Which drawing shows the plan elevations sections and other features?**

Working drawings Location drawings, also called general arrangement drawings, include floor plans, sections and elevations: they show where the construction elements are located.

## **What is a sectional view?**

A sectional view represents the part of an object remaining after a portion is assumed to have been cut and removed. The exposed cut surface is then indicated by section lines. Hidden features behind the cutting plane are omitted, unless required for dimensioning or for definition of the part.
