Moreover, how do you type **subscript** in CAD? Entering  $\hat{\alpha}^2$ , then selecting them and click the Stack button will get the squared effect. Entering  $\alpha^2$ , then selecting them and click the Stack button will get the subscripts.

You asked, how do you insert special characters in AutoCAD? Select The Symbol Then select the Text Editor from the top ribbon (if you can't see this, double click your text object to activate this menu). Select the Symbol button from the ribbon and select any symbol that you want to insert. Degree symbol and plus/minus symbol in **AutoCAD**.

Quick Answer, how do you text a subscript? Select the text or number that you want. For superscript, press Ctrl, Shift, and the Plus sign (+) at the same time. For subscript, press Ctrl and the Equal sign (=) at the same time.

1. Start the MTEXT command.
2. Type MM2^

3. Highlight 2<sup>^</sup>
  4. On the MTEXT toolbar, click the "Stack" button. (the one with the "a" over "b")
  5. You now have mm<sup>2</sup> (with a superscript).
1. In the MULTILINE TEXT EDITOR type the text that you wish to appear **subscript** followed by the caret (^) symbol.
  2. Highlight the text that you wish to change and the caret (^) symbol.
  3. Right click the mouse and select Stack from the drop down list.
  4. The selected text should now appear as superscript text.

## How do you add a suffix in AutoCAD?

1. In the drawing area, select the dimensions you want to edit.
2. Click Power Dimensioning tab Edit panel Edit Dim Text .
3. Click in the space between the dimension text and dimension text delimiter (1 in the illustration).
4. To insert a symbol:
5. Press ESC .

## How do I make text symbols in AutoCAD?

Inserting Character in Drawing: Start MTEXT in the drawing area and click on the symbol option in Insert panel of Text Editor tab. Select the "Other" option from the list of symbols to make character map visible. Select All Fonts (Private Characters) from font drop down menu as shown in the image below.

## Where is the symbols in AutoCAD?

The available symbols can be found at Ribbon panel -> View tab -> Palettes panel, to launch the palettes. Alternatively, use the keyboard combination CTRL+3 to access the same palettes. Some symbols can be found in the sample files that come with AutoCAD.

Inserting the squared symbol on your Android smartphone is relatively easy and straightforward. To insert the squared sign, just long-press the number 2 and it will insert the superscript 2.
