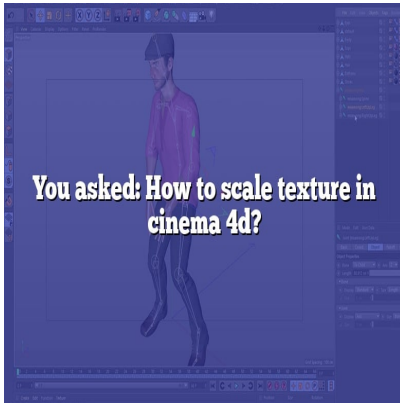

How do I size a keyframe in Cinema 4D?

1. STEP 1: SELECT THE OBJECT YOU WANT TO KEYFRAME IN THE OBJECT MANAGER.
2. STEP 2: GO TO THE FRAME IN THE TIMELINE RULER WHERE YOU WANT TO INSERT THE KEYFRAME.
3. STEP 3: PUSH THE SET KEY BUTTON IN THE ANIMATION PALETTE.
4. STEP 4: RINSE AND REPEAT.

The scale of shot, i.e. the apparent distance of the camera from the main subject of a scene, is one of the main stylistic and narrative functions of audiovisual products, conveying meaning and inducing the viewer's emotional state.

Plug the Roughness Map into the Roughness slot; Plug the Albedo map into the Color slot; Plug the Metalness map under the Layer Mask roll-out menu, in the Texture slot.

There are two areas in CINEMA 4D where you can adjust the materials, the Attribute Editor or the Material Editor. At the bottom of the timeline you should see the material manager, this displays any of the shaders you currently have in your scene.

What is UV mapping Cinema 4D?

UV Unwrapping is the process of flattening out a 3D model into a 2D representation for texture mapping. Think of a stuffed animal. It's made is by sewing together separated pieces of flat fabric based on a sewing pattern to create one sewn together animal.

1. Click the Stopwatch icon next to the property name to activate it. After Effects creates a keyframe at the current time for that property value.
2. Choose Animation > Add [x] Keyframe, where [x] is the name of the property you are animating.

1.1. Shot scale. Shot scale measures the relative distance of the camera from the main filmed object, and as such, it is tied to the size of the human figures on the screen and the relative ratio of the foreground to the background [1].
