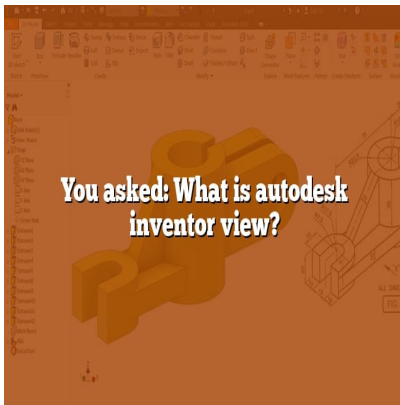

Also know, how do I change the **view** in **Autodesk Inventor**? Right-click ViewCube, and click Options. In the ViewCube Options dialog box, under When Clicking on the ViewCube, click Fit-to-View On View Change. When selected, you can click a pre-defined area of the ViewCube to reorient the model, and fit the model to the window. On the ribbon, click Tools tab Measure panel Measure . Or, click Measure on the marking menu. In Inventor assemblies only, if desired, select a selection priority: Component, Part, or Edges and Faces. Select the Advanced Settings drop-down arrow and set the dual units and precision values.

How do I view Autodesk Inventor files?

1. Click File Open.
2. In the dialog box, select the appropriate file type.
3. Browse to the folder that contains the Inventor file.
4. Select the part from the list.
5. To open the file, double-click the Inventor file name in the list, or click Open.

Parametric dimensions , a type of sketch constraint, control the size and position of geometry.

What is the first view you place in your drawing?

Base View. The first view created in a drawing. The base view is the source for subsequent views and controls the scale and alignment for them. You can create one or more base views on a drawing sheet.

What type of view will Inventor help you create automatically after you place a base view?

Inventor allows you to project views automatically after creating the first model view. You can only generate a Projected View if you have already placed at least one model view in the drawing. Projected Views are free to move about the sheet, while Isometric Views are children of the Base View and stay aligned.

How do you reset home view?

How do you become a metric Inventor?

Inventor “Override Units in Parts, Assemblies, and Presentations. To change the default unit of measure in the active file, go to Tools tab Options panel Document Settings and then select the Units tab in the dialog box. Select the Length drop-list to change units such as inches to mm.

Can eDrawings Open Inventor files?

eDrawings for Autodesk Inventor is a plug-in for Autodesk Inventor that allows users to publish, share, and collaborate representations of 2D and 3D product design data from Autodesk Inventor files as read only eDrawings files.

What is an Inventor File?

IDW files are the native Inventor format. You can open them only in Inventor or Inventor View. This file type results in smaller file sizes. The DWG file type is native to AutoCAD®. You can open DWG files in AutoCAD, Inventor, or DWG TrueView.

What is AnyCAD?

AnyCAD allows you to insert models as a reference and not a translated 3D CAD file. This helps when collaborating in a multi-CAD environment by reducing the amount of time you spend rebuilding your

models when an update happens. There are some rules and best practices you should think about when working with AnyCAD.

What is IPT File?

ipt extension is native Autodesk's Inventor Part file format for parts. It is used in combination with Autodesk assembly (.iam) files. IPT files can be imported in 3DS Max as Body Objects where the geometry in the ACIS solids format remains in the same format.
